**“Zombie Nouns, Passives, and Papers that can Argue: a Linguist’s View of the
Oddities of Special Languages”**

Prof. Dr. Dorgeloh is senior lecturer in English linguistics at the HHU Düsseldorf with a specialization in syntax, discourse analysis, and professional varieties of English. She received her PhD in 1995 with a dissertation on word order variation and completed her *Habilitation* in 2014 on the “Situating Meaning in Syntactic Form”. She has published widely on English grammar and its usage and is currently preparing a textbook with Cambridge University Press with the title “Discourse Syntax: English Grammar beyond the Sentence”. She is a member and vice-president of the HHU Senate.

Dr. Philipp Erchinger

“Earth Writing: Geography, Ecology, Literature”

Dr. Erchinger is lecturer in English literature at the HHU Düsseldorf. He specializes in 19th century poetry and prose, the intellectual history of the arts and sciences and, increasingly the ecology of literary work. He received his PhD from the University of Frankfurt in 2007 and completed his *Habilitation* (Erlangen) and *Umhabilitation* (Düsseldorf) in 2016 and 2017 respectively. His first monograph, a study on contingency and narrative form in Thomas Nashe, Laurence Sterne and Lord Byron, was published in 2009. His most recent book on ways of knowing in Victorian literature and science, entitled *Artful Experiments*, is due to appear with Edinburgh Press in 2018.
