CHECKLIST: Starting your studies

Enrolment: Before you can begin your studies, you must be officially enrolled. Once you have paid the semester fee, your student ID, which also functions as your semester ticket, as well as all the other necessary documents, will be sent to you.

Student ID: The student ID must be activated online. You receive your login details via mail.

Timetable: We recommend that you inform yourselves about the courses in which you want to participate as soon as possible. Registration is possible starting the 1st of September each winter term. In case you feel overwhelmed or still have questions, no problem: Your O-Tutors, the Student's Office and the Students' Committee can help you plan your semester. Materials: Would you rather work analogically or digitally, or a combination of both? Before starting your studies, think about which materials you need for a successful semester, like a weekly planner.
